To get you started, We've put together some easy to use instructions for your new headset system.

1. Unplug the coiled cord of your telephone handset from the base of your phone. In its place, insert the short, straight black connector cord (5) provided with your headset. (A)



2. Plug the coiled cord of your telephone handset into the back of your base unit (into the jack with the handset icon). (B)



3. Plug the other end of the short, straight black cord (5) into the jack on your base unit marked 'tel' (C)

4. Plug your headset (2) into the jack on the side of your base unit next to the headset icon. (E)



NO DIAL TONE? Check the following

-Batteries are installed correctly(or adaptor is plugged in)

-On/off button is pushed down to the 'On'position

-Speaker volume is turned up

-All cords are connected properly

If the headset still doesn't function, try an alternative compatibility setting. Slide the Compatibility selector switch(located on the left hand side of the amp), trying each of the four settings in order(1-4) until finding one that works best for your phone system.

Be kind to your batteries.

Proper battery installation is vital to the operation of your headset. Bear in mind that batteries will run down faster if the unit is consistently left in headset mode overnight. Check battery strength first if you experience any performance problems.

Volume control

Your amplifier is powerful, so adjust your volume carefully. Start with the headset volume control set at '1' and increase the volume gradually until you find a comfortable audio level.

Free Headset Hanger

Your amplifier includes a handy headset hanger. Just snap the stand onto the base and keep your desk clutter free.



Follow these simple instructions and have telephone headset up and running in no time

5. Adjusting your settings

push the On/Off switch. If the batteries (4) are installed correctly the indicator light (1) will glow green. If the light is red, the mute feature is on and the microphone is deactivated. Simply press the mute button (2) to get a solid green light. Start with headset volume control (3) set to '1' and work the volume gradually up to a comfortable audio level. To use your telephone handset instead of your headset, simply push the On/Off switch.

6. Fine-tuning your headset for use.

Wearing your Headset: Adjust the headset so the speaker fits comfortably over your ear(s).

The ear piece should sit on top of and cover the ear. Using a headset takes a little getting used to but it should always fit comfortably.

Headset Volume: With the telephone handset out of the cradle, you should hear a strong, clear dial tone through your headset. Adjust the headset volume with the volume control on top of the base unit.

Microphone Volume: The microphone volume control is on the right side of your base unit. (4) Set the microphone volume in on the middle. With the handset out of the cradle blow into loud.

You may then dial a number to make a call.

To hang up simply set the handset back in the cradle.
